Lois M. Wells Music Education Scholarship Program Guidelines

Scholarships may be available to any Seventh Day Baptist student attending a college, university or vocational training institute, who has met the following requirements:

- 1. Applicant must be a dedicated Christian with a strong witness and ability to encourage and inspire others through example and counsel, particularly young people.
- 2. Applicant intends to pursue a career in the field of Music Education.
- 3. Applicants shall submit with their application a statement from their pastor certifying their active participation, membership and involvement in a Seventh Day Baptist Church whenever he or she has been or is residing within commuting distance of the church. The Memorial Board would encourage recipients to attend institutions of higher learning which would enable the student to be regularly involved in the activities of a Seventh Day Baptist Church.
- 4. Scholarship grants shall be used for tuition, books, or room and board/ transportation which the applicant is required by the institution to pay. (Checks will be issued to the student and/or the educational institution.)

The exact amount of an individual's scholarship is dependent upon the total number of applicants and the amount of funds the trustees are able to allocate to the Scholarship Program.

5. Student applications are due no later than July 1 for the following year of schooling.
